

IMPORTANT INFORMATION—BULK MAILINGS (NEWS & NOTES/CHRIST IN OUR HOME)

As of November 15, 2009, the Fulton Post Office will no longer accept bulk mailings. This change in USPS policy will significantly increase postage costs for St. Paul's. As a result of this USPS change, St. Paul's would suggest that we transition to using the internet to communicate with members. All current mailings can be sent to member e-mail addresses. Some of the benefits of doing this are: reduced printing and paper costs, reduced postage costs and receiving important communications from St. Paul's in a more timely fashion. **We plan to continue to use the USPS for those that do not use the internet or just want hard copy.** Implementation will require building mass e-mail distribution system. We encourage you to participate in this transition from snail mail to electronic distribution. Please fill out the enclosed form for participation in the new process. Remember, if you still want to receive you communications via USPS just let us know on the card.
