- E. Water/Sewer Project
  - a. George Mader reported a \$26,000 discrepancy in the estimate we received for completion of the Water/Sewer project.
    - i. The estimate was sent in two parts.
    - ii. George received only one part.
    - iii. The actual total is between \$85,000 and \$90,000.
  - b. The merging of the land deeds will still continue as planned.
  - c. Other bids for the work are being requested.
  - d. John Murphy will contact John Moseman about renewing a "Well Guard" guarantee on the existing well system.
- F. Debbie Marston advised the Brotherhood that Debbie Cowell will be providing the refreshments at the Halloween Carnival this year.
  - a. Mike Heyser says a volunteer is needed to tell scary stories at the Carnival.
- G. Randy Arndt mentioned that volunteers are needed to assist with Habitats for Humanity construction projects.
